#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

To be eligible to apply for consideration for a scholarship from the SASS® Scholarship Foundation, the following criteria must be met:

- 1- Be an active SASS member for at least one year.
- 2- Be accepted or enrolled as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student at an accredited institution of higher education actively pursuing an academic or trade discipline.
- 3- Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA.

#### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The deadline for submission for the academic year **2025/2026 is May 1, 2025**. Your <u>completed</u> application mailing must be <u>postmarked</u> by the deadline date. **Electronic applications are not accepted.** Always ensure that all communication contains your full name, SASS number, alias, mailing address, email address, and daytime phone number.

## **APPLICATION PROCEDURES & INFORMATION**

Part I: Application – Complete the official SASS® Scholarship Application form
Part II: Resume – Prepare and submit a professional resume. Refer to the format template provided in this packet to compose your resume. It is important to include supporting documents such as recommendations, articles, certificates testimonials, and media from leadership in school, on the shooting range, extracurricular activities, and any academic achievements that demonstrate your motivation to serve and succeed.
Part III: Essay – submit a 300-500-word essay on the specified topic. Essay must be double spaced with the titl at the top, and each page must contain your name, SASS Alias and SASS number.
Academic Year 2025/2026 Applicants Essay Topic: Choose from one of the following topics:
<ol> <li>The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?</li> <li>Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.</li> </ol>
Part IV: Acceptance letter/Letter of intent - A): First time college students must supply a copy of the acceptance letter to the college/university/trade school to which you applied as evidence of your acceptance. OR- B) Renewing applicants or current college students must supply a GPA from the most recent semester and a list of classes for the coming semester/academic year.
<b>Part V: Transcripts</b> – High School students should attach a high school transcript (Spring 2023), first time college and renewing students may supply an unofficial fall semester/quarter, 2022 transcript. If your college has not sent out an acceptance letter by the time you have submitted your application, please submit a letter stating this, then submit a copy once it is received.
Part VI: Letters of Recommendation- Application must include 3 letters of recommendation. (no more/ness) from any of the following: fellow SASS members, teacher/professor, community leader, or employer. *No letters from immediate family or SASS employees will be accepted.
Part VII: Photographs – submit no more than 3 photos- at least one full color in full Cowboy attire wearing you SASS® badge, in a high-resolution PDF or JPG format for <i>The Cowboy Chronicle</i> . *Emal the photograph submission directly t scholarship@sassnet.com. Subject line must read: "Scholarship Photo: LEGAL NAME – SASS ALIAS – SASS #"
